SUBJECT : *Implementation of Virtual or Online Meeting, Videoconferencing, Webcasting and Similar Technology in the Procurement Activities in the CSC-Central Office In Time of a State of Calamity, Community Quarantine or Similar Restrictions*

In view of the “New Normal” and “Work from Home” arrangement in the Civil Service Commission in time of a state of calamity or community quarantine or similar restrictions, the CSC Central Office Bids and Awards Committee (CSC-CO BAC) will be implementing bidding or procurement activities through *virtual meeting, videoconferencing, webcasting or similar technology* via **Microsoft Teams online conference**. The online platform may be used exclusively or in combination with face-to-face interactions for all procurement activities of the BAC as the case may be.

The CSC-BAC is also adopting relevant guidelines issued by the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) as well as the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 on the measures for the efficient conduct of procurement activities during the period of community quarantine/similar restrictions.
